
# **NAVARRA WINES:**

### 1 - TIERRA ESTELLA

#### **Description**

Located in the Northwest, boarding the Basque Country and La Rioja, along the "Way of Saint James".

Pronounced hilly landscape with mountain ranges to the north.

Highest average altitude and notable Atlantic influence.

**Main Varieties:** : Tempranillo, Cabernet Sauvignon, and Chardonnay.

**Soils:** heavy clay, marl, loam, gravel and sand

Vineyard area: 1,800 hectares

Main town: Estella

### 2 - RIBERA BAJA

#### **Description**

Southern area near the town of Tudela, in the Ebro valley.

Fertile river plain framed by Moncayo mountain range to the south and Bardenas Reales desert 15 miles east.

Mediterranean influenced climate, warmest of the zones with less rainfall

**Main Varieties:** Tempranillo, Garnacha, Viura and Moscatel.

Soils: : loam, stony, limestone, marl, sand

Vineyard area: 3,350 hectares

Main town: Tudela

### 3 – VALDIZARBE

#### Description

North central portion of the region in the heartland of the "Way of Saint James" Mountain ranges to the west and north, the Arga River runs through the area forming a landscape of gentle hills and valleys.

Most humid area, Atlantic climate influence

Main Varieties: : Tempranillo, Garnacha, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, and Chardonnay

Soils: marl, loam, alluvial

Vineyard area: : 920 hectares

Main town: Puente la Reina

## 4 - RIBERA ALTA

#### **Description**

The heart of Navarra, bordering Aragón and Rioja. The Rio Ega flows through the middle and at the center is the medieval town of Olite.

Gentle landscape with high terraces.

Continental climate transitioning from Atlantic to Mediterranean climate Warmer area compared to the northern zones with less rainfall.

Main Varieties: Tempranillo, Graciano, Chardonnay, Petit Grain Moscatel Soils: : loamy-clay, marl, sand and

limestone

Vineyard area: 4,125 hectares

Main towns: Tafalla and Olite

#### 5 - BAJA MONTANA

#### **Description**

Located in the northeastern area, at the foothills of the Pyrenees Mountains, bordering Aragón region. Many Rosados come from here.

Marked by a pronounced relief

Mixed Atlantic/Continental climate

Main Varieties: : Garnacha and

Tempranillo

**Soils:** marl, loam, sand, limestone and

gravel

Vineyard area: 1.520 hectares

Main town: Sangüesa
